

Create a Montage Present it to your Peers

A *montage* is the art of arranging several sources in composition so that the elements are both distinct and blended to represent the whole. You will be creating a montage to introduce yourself to your teacher and classmates. The montages will be posted in the 8th grade hallway once they are complete.

POSTER: Size 14" X 22" (One **half** of a poster board)

Criteria:	3 adjectives that describe you	(3 points)
	3 nouns that describe you	(3 points)
	Picture of self or self with family	(3 points)
	3 other visual images representing you	(3 points)
	1 quote that "is you"/speaks to you	(5 points)
	Quality (neatness, creativity, accuracy)	(5 points)
	On time with name included - large and legible	(3 points)

Total: 25 Points

PRESENTATION:

You will need to answer these questions in your presentation. Your presentation should last 2 to 3 minutes.

Tell us about you using your montage in the style of a podcast.
What are your strongest attributes/characteristics?
Explain a couple of items from your piece. Be informative but enthusiastic (VOICE matters).

Criteria:

Voice/Clarity - (clear, audible, avoidance of "ums" and other fillers)	(4 points)
Eye contact with your audience	(3 points)
Appropriate body language (Posture, facial expression)	(3 points)
Evidence of planning for presentation well in advance	(5 points)
Interesting	(5 points)
Unusual start/strong hook (Do NOT start with "I did my montage on..." but instead start with a story or an interesting fact. (Soccer has been part of my life since... or Six years ago, I discovered...))	(5 points)
