BEHAVIOR POLICY AND CONTRACT:

Tappan Sixth Grade Class Trip

- We believe that all of our students know how to appropriately behave and know that it is essential to follow the instructions of adult staff while in school and on field trips
- Rules and expectations for appropriate behavior have been thoroughly discussed with all students
- The student and parent/guardian are required to sign this contract for a student to be eligible for participation in this year's 6th Grade Class Trip

Behavioral Standards Required for Participation in 6th Grade Class Trip:

A student who has any of the following after October 1st:

- **A citizenship score of 4 or 5**
- **One or more VOE ("Violation of Expectation") referrals for not following staff directions**
- **Suspensions from school**

may possibly be excluded from this class trip, but will be considered for trip participation on an individual basis. A decision on trip participation will follow a conference with the student, his/her parent, teachers, and the administrator.

All regular school rules will be in effect on field trips. If a student demonstrates inappropriate/unacceptable behavior while on a trip, the following consequences will go into effect:

- 1) The student will be assigned to a Tappan staff member, and sit out for the remainder of the activity.**
- 2) If the inappropriate behavior is deemed to be extremely serious or dangerous, or if the student repeats behavior that is inappropriate, the student will sit out for the remainder of the activity with a Tappan staff member and a parent/guardian will be notified by telephone to come take the child home.**

I understand the standards required for participation in the 6th Grade Class Trip and the consequences for inappropriate behavior while on field trips.
